Easter Hams---John brought the members up to date on the Ham/Canned Food Drive. Steve and Don volunteered to collect the cans each Friday and deliver them to the Lion's Food Bank. They will also collect the tickets and issue new ones. Tickets will be placed in the drum at the Senior Center. Myron will contact the Lion's Club to make sure someone would be at the Food Bank on Fridays.
