TJ Keiran, Planner for the City of Castle Rock gave a brief overview of the proposed zoning code and recommended amendments to the Comprehensive Plan for the City of Castle Rock. He invited business leaders and other concerned citizens to attend the April 16th Planning Commission Meeting at the Castle Rock Senior Center.
