Some help may be needed to set up the tents, tables and chairs. Volunteers would be appreciated to help serve, etc.

Motorcycle Races—The National Motorcycle Races will be held at the Castle Rock Race Track (Fairgrounds) on August 10 and 11.

Rock Dollar Day—Myron reported that he had excellent response from the business community for Rock Dollar Day. Twenty-seven businesses have signed on. The Chamber of Commerce will pay for a full-page ad in the *Valley Bugler*. Businesses will give a 10% discount on an order of \$15. or more. (Some exclusions apply.)
